Physical description of Ben Martin comes from his "Certificate of Disability for Discharge" from the Army of the United States, Army of the United States (Yankee): Benj. F. Martin, Private, was born in Green Co., Ky., 5 feet 8 inches high, dark complexion, gray eyes, dark hair, and by occupation was a farmer. He filed for disability because of an attack of "chills and fever". After his disability release he had "piles" very bad to the point of hemorrhaging and over the years could only work about 1/3 of what a normal man could do. He also had hearing loss and it got worse as he got older.

On the way to Kentucky he met Martha Dow Hale in Derrick, Ark., stayed about a week, just long enough to get her pregnant. He went on to Kentucky but got to thinking about maybe a baby coming and went back to Arkansas to marry Martha. Apparently there was a baby so she packed baby and quilt and they left for Oklahoma. This is apparently when the whole family left for Oklahoma or the Martins followed later.
