Kentucky Citizens, List of Fines Assessed [With Endorsement by Lincoln]¹, January 31, 1863

[Note 1 Colonel John W. Foster of the 65th Indiana volunteers had levied assessments on purported avowed Kentucky secessionists, the proceeds of which were to reimburse the loyal Unionist victims of guerrilla depredations in that state. He had the after-the-fact approval of his commander, General Jeremiah T. Boyle. Lincoln was disturbed over the potential for abuse that existed in such a practice. See Lincoln to Jeremiah T. Boyle, February 1, 1863, Boyle to Lincoln, February 11, 1863, and John W. Foster to Boyle, January 6, 1863 and February 16, 1863.]
