dated this 19th day of December 1793

is a Marriage shortly Intended to be Solemnized Between the above
Bound Benjamin Sampson & Margaret Warren
for which a License has issued Now if there be no Lawfull cause to
Obstruct the said Marriage then this obligation to be void Else to
Remain In full force
