 money, the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, &c.,
 jointly, severally and firmly, by these presents; sealed and dated, this *24th*
 day of *August* 185*2*.

THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that, whereas, there is a License about to issue
 from the Clerk's Office of the *Lincoln* County Court, for a marriage intended, between
 the above bound *John Warren* and *Martha J. Peoples*.

Now if there should be no lawful cause to obstruct said marriage, then this obligation to be
 void—else to remain in full force and virtue.
