and Aquilla Wiley are held and firmly bound
unto his Excellency the Governor of Kentucky in the sum of Fifty
Pounds current money, To the payment whereof to be made to the
said Governor and his Successors we bind ourselves our Heirs Family
By this Presents sealed with our seals and dated this 29th day of
August 1792

The Condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas there is
a Marriage ^{contract} intended to be solemnized Between the above Bound
Benjamin Wiley and Elizabeth Warren
For which a license has been given, Now if there be no lawful cause to
obstruct the said Marriage then this obligation to be void and else
to remain in full force
