



at the surrender of Lord Cornwallace [sic: Cornwallis, 19 Oct 1781] he was detailed as one of the guard to guard the British prisoners to the Barracks in Frederick County Virginia here he was discharged by his said Captain Triplett, he served in this tour two months & received a discharge therefor but has lost this also. He knows of no living witness by whom he can prove his services

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension Roll of the Agency of any State
