I give and bequath to my friend (and if I shall live long enough I intend to make him my adopted Son by law) William Winters all of my estate both real & personal to have and to hold for ever and I hereby appoint William Crockett my husband as executor of this my last will and Testament revoking all former will by me made, and declare this to be my last will and testament. Witness I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 13th day of July 1855
