this to be paid fifty dollars yearly beginning at
the oldest until all is paid. I also will to my
wife Catharine all the house hold furniture
bedding and so forth to have and to hold ~~this~~ her
lifetime and after her death what is left to be equally
divided between all the heirs. It is also my
will that my son Samuel shall take good care
of his mother her life time as man & Samuel Hamer
attest
