Wible to be my Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In Witness whereof I have hereunder set my name and affix^d my seal this twenty first day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand and eight hundred and fifty seven John Hartson

The above written instrument was subscribed by the said John Hartson in our presence and acknowledged by him to each of us and he at the same time published and declared the above instrument to be his last will and testament and we at the testator required and in his presence have signed our names as witness unto and written opposite our names our respective places of residence
