first after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged and funeral and burial expenses is made - the residue of my estate real and personal I give bequeath and dispose of as follows: First, To my oldest daughter Caroline McRoy, in which I have given one hundred dollars and a horse and saddle and one Milch Cow and one Bed and I do hereby give to my oldest daughter Caroline McRoy - one dollar more - And to my oldest son Essex P. Miller one hundred dollars and a horse & a good saddle & a Milch Cow & a bed - And to my second Son P. Miller one One hundred dollars & a horse & a good saddle & one Milch Cow & a Bed and to my second daughter Marean Miller one hundred dollars & a horse & a good saddle & a milch Cow, & a bed, and the remainder of my estate both personal or real I do hereby give to my beloved wife Martha Miller to hold and to keep her naturall life or her widowhood - and at her death or marriage the remaining portion of my estate both personal & real is to go to my three youngest Children Essex P. Miller Son P. Miller & to Marean Miller equally divided a between the three - and lastly of all I do hereby appoint my beloved wife Martha Miller my Executer over my will & testament -
