First I desire all my just debts and my burial be first paid and then I bequeath to my first set of children to my oldest daughter Elizabeth Shurt one dollar and to my son Hammon Jefferson Miller one dollar & to my son Isaac Miller one dollar & to my son Alfred Miller one dollar & to my son Thomson Miller one dollar & to my daughter Mary Read one dollar & to my son James Montgomery Miller one dollar & to my daughter Susan Miller one dollar which is all of my first set of children. And as to my last set of children I bequeath to the oldest girl Tennessee Miller one dollar & to the second girl Cassandra Miller one dollar & to the third a son Simon Miller one dollar. The remaining portion of my estate including my land and cash notes and cash tank all my personal property and all to my beloved wife Maria Helmina Miller to hold and to keep & to dispose of and to raise the children and to hold forever.

In testimony whereof I have unto set my hand and seal and publish and declare this to be my last will and testament this in the year of our Lord One thousand and eight hundred & sixty four.
