Know all men by these presents, that eye Simon Miller in the County of Muhlenburg and State of Kentucky being in full and declining health but of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former Will by me at any time heretofore made

First I desire all my just debts and my burial be first paid and then I bequeath to my first set of children to my eldest daughter Elizabeth Sturt one dollar and to my son Hamlet Miller one dollar and to my son Isaac Miller one dollar and to my son Alfred Miller one dollar and to my son Thomson Miller one dollar and to my daughter Margary Read one dollar and to my son James Montgomery Miller one dollar and to my daughter Susan Miller one dollar which is all of my first set of children = and as to my last set of children I bequeath to the oldest girl Tennessee Miller one dollar and to the second girl Louisa Miller one dollar and to the third a son Simon Miller one dollar - The remaining portion of my estate including my land and cash notes and cash and all my personal property and all to my beloved wife Maria Melvina Miller to hold and to keep and to dispose of and to raise the children and to hold forever

In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal and publish and declare this to be my last will and testament this in the year of our Lord one thousand and eight hundred and sixty four -
