

William Allison's Will.

I, William Allison, of the state of Kentucky and Muhlenberg County constitute, ordain and establish this my last will and testament.

It is my will and desire that my friends William Imbler & Hugh Carter after my death shall sell all my stock, household & kitchen furniture giving twelve months credit thereon.

It is also my friends William Imbler and Hugh Carter shall sell my land whereon I now live and give 6 years credit. All my notes will be collected as they fall due for the use of my children.

Immediately after the money becomes due my will and desire is that it be put into the treasury and the interest thereof to be applied to the benefit of the youngest children.

It is also my will and desire that as each of my children becomes of age they shall draw their proportionable part. This is my last will and testament, sealed with my seal.
