Allison one half of my kitchen furniture & one room - I give to my son Samuel S. Allison one feather bed - And to my two sons William S. Allison & Hannan E. Allison I give two dollars each

I do hereby revoke all & every other will heretofore made by me In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 22nd of July 1833
