


In the name of God amen. I Elisha Atkinson of Muhlenberg

in to the hands of the allmighty god that give it and my Body
I recomend to the earth to be buried in decent christian burial
at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the
general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of god and as touching such worldly Estate
where with it has pleased god to Bless me in this life devise as
follows - first I give and ordain that my Son Jowel Atkinson
to have a Descent Separt out of my Estate with the assistants of
a negro woman named Migge and Magge is to live with Jowel
during his natural life and at his death with Amos John. S.
which she see cause Magge is to return to my Estate and
valued and is to go to Amos and John. S. Atkinson
and the woman Magge is to have choise which of them
she live with after my decease I give to my Son Jith the
cattale that he has and ten dollars then I give to my
Son - Hlerr one horse to be valued to fifty dollars
then I give to my daughter Betty the cattale that she
has had and ten dollars and then I give to my Son
Amos a young negro woman named fanny and a
negro boy named Lurrel during his natural life
at his death he divided amongst his children and
then I lend my Son John. S. Atkinson a negro Boy
named Lewis and fanny eldest child named Sina
at a three years old during his life and at his death
to go to one if John. S. should dy without heir
the negroes to return to my Estate and the Ballance
of my Estate to be Equally divided between Amos
and John. S. Atkinson and I do appoint Amos
Atkinson and John. S. Atkinson as my Executors
and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and his
annul all and every other manner testaments will
legises bequests executors By me in any wise before
named will and bequeathed (ratifying and
confirming this and no other to be my last will and
testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this the twenty sixth

of February in the year of our lord Eighteen hun-
dred and twenty
