for all men to die I have thought proper while in my perfect  
mind to make this my last will & Testament = In the first place my  
will is that all of my just Debts be paid Secondly I give and bequeath  
to my beloved wife Elizabeth Givvin all of my estate both real and personal  
I do hereby appoint my wife Elizabeth Givvin executor to this my last will  
and Testament I do hereby revoke and make void all former wills by me  
made and declare this to be my last will and Testament = In testimony  
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November in  
the year of our Lord 1848 =
