In the name of God Amen I Thomas Irwin Senier
of the County of Estu blenberg and State of Kentucky being
Weak in body but of sound mind and memory and calling
to recollection that it is appointed for all mankind once to
die do think proper to make this my last Will and Testament
I send the best Iles my Will and desire that my just
Debts be paid and satisfied by my Executors to be hereafter
named Item the Decend I give grant and bequeath to
my beloved Wife Jane Irwin one horse two cows one head
and signature and four head of sheep and shee the said Jane
is to have her support and from the plantation on which
I now live and my negro man Starry is to work for her and
my Daughter Polly and I Rebecca during her the said Jane's
lifetime unless they or either of them should before that time
think proper to marry Item I give grant and bequeath
that the 200 hundred acre survey of Land lying in this
County which I purchased from James Duncan be equally divided
between my daughter Polly and the children of Robert
Duncan Black and Rebecca Irwin and that Polly Irwin part
of her land of adjoining the 40 acre tract of Land with her
marriage and I further give grant and bequeath to said Polly
and I Rebecca Irwin one horse one creature and one cow each
together with one head of signature each to the three last
mentioned persons and also I do give signature to Lucinda
Irwin & it is Charles to be under stood that the children
of Estu Lepps Clark are to get one fourth of said Land as
mentioned in this Item as the part of my daughter
Nancy Clark Item the fourth It is my last Will that
the tract of Land in my name on position in this
County be equally divided between James Irwin and John
Esperlan so that James Irwin have his improvement thereon
Item the fifth at the Decend of my Wife Jane Irwin
I provide that my negro man Starry should survive her
at my desire that he be hired out to some of my heirs
annually if it should do hurt if not here to others and his
wages divided amongst my children equally

Item the death I bequeath to Pally Irwin the 40 acre tract of land lying in this County taken up surveyed & patented in her name to her I her heirs forever
 Item Seventh I give and bequeath to John Garrison & Elizabeth his wife the tract of land entered in the name of James of Hartney in this County and Poss. Given to them I there heirs forever. Item Eighth I give and bequeath to Thomas Irwin of the 200 Acre Survey and which I now live and I have made one beac of signature to be his forever
 Item the Ninth I give and bequeath to the children of George & Peggy Young four head of ~~of~~ cattle Lastly I do hereby appoint James Irwin and Thomas Irwin of Executors to this my last will and testament hereby ratifying & confirming that I do other to be my last will and testament in testimony where of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 12 day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Twenty three
