lifetime but nothing to be given away 2^d I desire to give
my son Calvin B. Mitchell all that I have paid for him
and Charles and Twenty five Dollars to his daughter
Mary Rebecca that is in Sumner 3^d That Elias Laughter
had Twenty five Dollars 4th I want William Buchanan
to hold the place he now lives on provided he will pay
one thousand Dollars 5th I want all my just debts paid
to Amos Mearns Lysanna and W. H. Mitchell and
Benjamin Kintel to the rest of my Estate Equally and
between them 7th There is an old note in Sumner they say
against me that I have paid off July Twenty six or seven
years ago I appoint John G. Stewart my Executor of this
my last will and Testament hereby Reading as other
former wills or Testaments heretofore made in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my this 16th day
of July 1857
