

Greenville Ky 20 Apr 1891

Know all men by these presents that I E E Gussenburg of the
County of Muhlenberg County and State of Kentucky bring
in sound mind and memory do make and declare This
to be my last will and testament

First I bequeath to my two Sons Davis & Ed the homestead upon
which we now live containing about (150) One hundred and
fifty acres of land for their portion of my estate

Secondly I will that by my two Sons relinquishing interest in and
unto the old James Gussenburg homestead to their three sisters
that my three Daughters shall have the said homestead Con-
taining One Hundred & fifty acres without any encumbr-
ance & my two Sons will or do agree to pay to smooth my soul Jims
W. Bee and they agree to the terms herein

(3) Thirdly I design for my two Sons Davis & Ed to have One
horse each after which all or any part of my personal pro-
perty that it may take to pay all my just & legal - After ap-
plying the proceeds of the personal property to the payment

of my debts if there are any debts remaining, my two
sons is to assume them

I appoint my son Lewis my administrator and J G
Youtz his assistant
