


Abraham Unsel

unto my son David one dollar it being his part of my
Estate I also will and bequeath unto my son william one
Dollar it being his part of my Estate I also will and
Bequeath unto Annah my deare and Beloved wife the
Remainning part of all my Estate to have at her ~~disposal~~
To do with it as long as she lives and To Will or leave it
as she sees proper at her decease as witness whereof I have
set my hand and caused my seal to be fixed this 16th
Decemba 1819
