Vincent in money and personal property each Five hundred dollars as their distributable share of my estate. I give to my beloved wife all the estate that I now possess, after paying all of my just debts, to have and to hold the same for her use and benefit during her lifetime and ^{at} her death I want it all sold and the proceeds equally divided among my eleven youngest children, viz: Andrew Vincent, Lucy Vincent, Felix Vincent, Thomas Q. Vincent, Sarah A. Vincent Charlie A. Vincent, William H. Vincent, N. E. Vincent, Daten Vincent, Milton Vincent, & W. A. Vincent. I hereby give to my wife power to sell privately or publicly any personal property hereby bequeathed to her and her children & use the proceeds as she may see proper.
