His remains were badly decomposed when he

was found, but his remains were moved to the placed mentioned on Laurel Creek. “JOINTLY THE Davidson AND BAILY CLANS FOUNDED THE SETTLEMENT WHICH LATER BECAME BLUEFIELD, VirginIA & WEST VirginIA.”  
“Some other family burial places according to a book called "Tazewell County VA, Some Old Cemetaries" from the Tazewell County History Assoc.: Richard Bailey Sr.'s grave and a DAR marker is on he south side of Rt 19/460 Bluefield VA bypass, on the west side of the access road to the horse stables near the state line. At the junction of Rt 102 east and rt. 102 west there is a big boulder with a plaque from the DAR commenorating the Bailey-Davidson fort. The actual fort sight is now a Westgate Shopping Center. John Bailey abd Nancy Davidson and some of their kids are in the Bailey Cemetary behind Whitethorn School between Maryland Ave and Walton Ave in Bluefield WV. There are only fieldstones in this cemetery, but there is a marker for John Bailey at the school. Some early Davidsons are buried in an old apple orchard behind something called the Wilburn House on Whitethorn St. I'm sure that someone who lives closer to Bluefield could give you more information about these places. per Kay Robinett krobinett@aol.com “
