The lack of documentation of the children of John Travis (1713-?) makes things hard. I have no solid proof that my Martha (1736-1829) was the d/o John and probably will never have anything more than an educated guess. Such is the nature of genealogy. Between the fires Gen. Sherman set on his tour of the South and the burning of old wooden courthouses, much of our heritage has been lost. If there were any family Bibles, they seem to have been lost as well. The information I gave you that agrees with the new book seems pretty solid. It represents recent research by a man who is kin to Gen. Travis and who set out to prove Gen. Travis' work. He couldn't. For those of us who descend from Dr. Edward Travis of Bath, NC, our line changes very little. We are descended from William rather than Edward, both sons of William and Agnes (Lathom) Travers. We can still trace our lineage back to 1066 in the Travis line and through the Lathoms back to the dawn of history. I know how you feel at this point.
