

Could not the November Voucher be paid without the cost of having an Administrator appointed, costing more than the amount due, as this is all the old lady had left. This would only go toward paying her funeral expenses. In a few cases with Civil War Veterans, I have been able to collect the amount due them at the time of thier death, filing claim as sworn to by undertaken or nurse.

As a lawyer, I realize the proper steps, but also know the cost incured in these cases, which often times exceeds the

amount collected.
