

GRAYSON WOMAN DIES WHEN NEAR HER CENTENARY

Supported 5 Children By Her Skill In Domestic Art.

Grayson, Ky., Jan. 22,—There died here this morning the oldest known person in Northeast Kentucky, Mrs. Susan Netherzutt Armstrong, mother of Attorney George Armstrong and Mrs. W. C. Holcomb, of Grayson.

She would have been 100 years old next August.

Mrs. Armstrong was born in Russell county, Virginia, and came to Carter county when a child. She lost her husband during the war between the States, and by indomitable energy and industry provided for her family of five children.

She was skillful in domestic arts, being able to card, spin and weave all kinds of wool, cotton and linen and carpet.

She was a lifelong member of the Christian Church.
