



Mungul Hill

 I give and bequath to the said Joseph John Wells
 one Horse Lot Farts to him and his heirs forever. I give
 and bequath to said Joseph John Wells one Yoke of
 Oxen an Wheels an Cart to him and his heirs forever
 I give and bequath to the said Joseph John Wells one
 Negro man slave cal Nathan to him an his heirs
 former. I give and bequath to the said Joseph John
 Wells one Currow to him and his heirs forever. I give
 an bequath to Martha Drake the wife of Elias Drake
 one Negro woman nam'd Jude to her and her heirs
 forever. I give and bequath to
 Reveramy Drake one Negro man cal Edlick
 to her and her heirs forever. I give an bequath to
 Saray Grippen one Negro woman cal Young hager
 to her and her heirs forever. I give an bequath to Ann
 Drake and his one Negro man cal Danial to her
 and her heirs forever. I give an bequath to Mary
 Pennington late Mary Drake an Cary Pennington late
 Cary Fortay one Negro woman Catharine to them
 and their heirs forever. I give an bequath to
 Josiah Wells Twenty five Dollars to him an his
 heirs forever. I have also given him 200 acres of Land
 by deed. My will is that my Negro woman cal old
 Bager Shactay with my Grandson Joseph John
 Wells an Cook for him. I give to the said
 Joseph John Wells my stock of Hogs. My Will is
 that all the rest of property shall be sold
 an Equely divided between my Children hereafter
 mentioned to wif: Reveramy Drake Sara Grippen
 Ann Drake Mara Pennington late Mara Drake
 an Cary Pennington late ~~Martha~~ ^{Mary} Fortay My will
 is that them two shall have one share. My will
 is that if my wife Ann Wells lives longer then
 I doo she shall have and posses all my property
 during her natural life then for the said to go
 to them it is divided two. Sept the 10 day 1850

The foregoing last Will and Testament of Micajah
 Nees deceased, was exhibited into Court, & proved to
 be the act & deed of the Said Micajah Nees by the
 Oaths of William Drake, Charles F. King & Wm. King
 the subscribing Witnesses thereto, and motion being
 made to Record the Same, & Objections thereto being
 made, Said motion was continued till the next
 Court - and at the November County Court 1831 Said
 Will was again presented to the Court, & the Court
 being more fully advised of both the argument of
 Counsel & the testimony introduced, it is ordered that
 Said Will be Recorded
